Summer Camp Rules

We earnestly desire that everyone enjoy their week at camp, and these rules are for the benefit and safety of all.

- 1) **LISTEN** when someone is speaking, give respect to authority.
- 2) **NO ELECTRONICS!** (cell phones, music players, video games, e-book readers, etc.) Cell phones brought to camp must be turned off and handed in to the nurse for safekeeping. Parents may contact the camp directly if they have questions or concerns during the week of camp (Tim Lindsay 208.881.8667).
- 3) **ABSOLUTELY NO PRANKS!** They always get out of hand, and people get hurt.
- 4) **NO GRAFFITI ALLOWED!** Do not write or draw on camp property, such as cabins and bathrooms. If you want to draw on something, there are spare pages in your devotion books, or use a notebook.
- 5) **NO** food in cabins or at campfire. There are wild animals in our region, so we must be careful.
- 6) **COME READY** to activities. Use the bathroom before activities, and come dressed appropriately.
- 7) **NO** leaving camp property unless participating in a camp scheduled activity.
- 8) **ONLY** ride bikes during designated times as a cabin group or during choice of activities.
- 9) **NO** obstacle course or zipline without permission from the Program Director and supervision by a staff member.
- 10) **PROHIBITED ITEMS: CELL PHONES, cigarettes, alcohol, guns, knives, unprescribed drugs, fireworks, lighters, laser pointers, walkie talkies, and anything that will distract from God or one another.**
- 11) **Areas that are OFF-LIMITS for campers:**
 - i. The kitchen
 - ii. Other cabins. Guys must stay on the guy's side of camp, gals must stay on their own side, as well. This also applies to the restrooms.
 - iii. The Sharp Zone (the woods opposite the dodgeball court, across the road)
 - iv. The RV Park and all camper trailers

Dress Code

What we wear at camp should be pleasing to God, so campers and staff are to bring conservative and informal clothes.

1. NO underwear is to be visible at any time!
2. NO hats or clothing with print that contains violence, foul language, vulgar artwork, or ripped/cut shirts. Pants must not have holes above the mid-thigh.
3. PANTS must be worn during paintball and Capture the Flag (this is for the camper's safety)!

Guys:

- Shirts and shoes must be worn at all times. Shirts cannot be cut down the sides. Sleeveless shirts are allowed, but must have wide shoulder straps, and not be an undershirt.

Girls:

- No spaghetti straps. Tank tops must not be sheer, see-through, or low cut. We are very active at the camp, so wear shirts that will be modest, even if you bend over. All visible shoulder straps must be 3-fingers wide or wider.
- No short shorts. Holding your hand loosely at your side, shorts must be down to the tips of your fingers (this should be on the lower end of the mid-thigh). You will be given a warning, but if you continue to wear shorts that are too short, you will either wear pants or wear shorts we provide.
- Swimwear is to be a one-piece suit, with 3-finger wide straps, modest, with mid-thigh shorts. Many campers wear shirts over their swimwear.

The Camp Director has the final say on any questionable clothes.

Continued rebellion and disregard for the rules may result in the camper being sent home.

These are typical send-home offenses:

(Parents are responsible to arrange transportation for their child if being sent home is deemed necessary.)

1. **Violence to others, bullying**
2. **Blatant and continued disrespect**
3. **Stalking or lurking on the other gender side of camp**
4. **Running away (for their own safety)**
5. **Self-harm (for their own safety)**
6. **Use of prohibited items while at camp, such as alcohol, drugs, etc.**
7. **Anything the camp deems as harmful**
